- i) UPDATE TO Roadworks – via What's on in Nocton – quote: “I had a conversation with the gentleman in charge of the patching's work. Any patching in Nocton and up to Station Road, junction in Potterhanworth has been cancelled due to no money being available. His words were "beyond April". So not much hope and they will have postponed any pot hole repairs on those sections, so they need reporting asap. Station Road Potterhanworth is being closed from 15th October for 5 days, so bus services will be disrupted that week. The road from Metheringham to Martin Moor is being closed for 7 weeks.”.
